Preliminary Rally Itinerary – Draft for Review Only

DAY 1 TUESDAY, JULY 21

- Arrive, Park (Bob Small, the Prouds First VP, is the Parking Coordinator), and Register at Terry Bison Ranch & RV Park
- [Take I-25 to WY Exit #2 (Terry Ranch Road) turn south and follow signs 2 miles; Terry Bison Ranch (TBR) is a working guest ranch **"The West at its Best"**.
 - • the club is dry camping at TBR however the property does have a dump station; check out TBR's website at www.TerryBisonRanch.com]
- Coach washing is provided so get your name on the list!
- Rally Registration & Packet Pick-Up – 9:00 am-4:00pm – in the 100 year old "Wagon Wheel" building is right across from the Terry Rail Express!
- Bison Tours – Use the ticket in your rally packet, board the TBR Train, and head to the open range for bison!
- Converter Display Opens – 2:00pm – adjacent to parking area
- Golf Tournament (Dave Petersen is the Golf Coordinator) & Motorcycle Riders Meeting led by Frank Konigseder with Liberty Coach – 3:00pm
- Big Cowboy Welcome for First-Timers w/Club Management coordinated by Susan Ball – 4:00pm
- "Welcome to Wyoming & Cheyenne Frontier Days" – tonight features a greeting from Cheyenne Frontier Days officials, club-served Social, Dinner, and Live Entertainment (5:30-7:00pm in the Wagon Wheel building)
- Join in the Sing-Along Under the Wyoming Stars! – Converters Stage – We'll start about 7:45pm and go until sunset!



DAY 2 WEDNESDAY, JULY 22

- Morning Optional Breakfast Activities (*choose one*):
 - Special Early Morning Pancake Breakfast at the Depot Plaza in Historic Downtown Cheyenne; flapjacks are served hot off the grill to lots of hungry visitors; *runs from 7-9am*
 - Cowboy Breakfast – on-site in the Wagon Wheel
- Mid/Late-Morning Optional Frontier Days Activities (*choose one and registration is requested for all listed activities below*):
 - Behind the Chutes Tours – a 40-minutes behind-the-scenes look at Cheyenne Frontier Days Rodeo events including a visit to the “chutes” (*this activity is held each day of our rally; from 10-10:40am*)



-Wild Horse Gulch & Indian Village – take a step back in time and celebrate western heritage, meet Western merchants, craftspeople, artisans and special guest characters (*event held each day of rally beginning at 10am; self-guided; stroll at your own pace*)

-Wyoming Air National Guard Air Show – parachute and aerial demonstrations, aircraft static displays and flyovers – *event held only today; opens at 8:30am; access onto base is via shuttle bus; lunch at CFD Old West Tent then attend 12:45pm Rodeo*

- USAF Thunderbirds – breathtaking aerial acrobatics across the clear blue skies of Cheyenne (*Laramie Country Community College is the “flyover focus point” and where we’re headed; event held only today*)



- Lunch – Old West Tent in front of Old West Museum & Store & CFD Office – *From 11:30am to 12:30pm; shuttle from tent to Arena for 12:45pm Rodeo Performance*
- Rodeo Action – we’re headed to Frontier Park Arena for an afternoon of non-stop action including bull riding, saddle bronc, bareback, steer wrestling/roping, team roping, tie-down roping, barrel racing and the famous wild horse race; *rodeo starts at 12:45pm to 4:30pm*
- “Old West” Prevost Prouds’ Club Business Meeting – On-site in the Wagon Wheel
- Cheyenne Social – immediately following the Club’s Business Meeting; *w/ Heavy Appetizers; Live Entertainment*
- Free Night
- Sing-Along Under the Wyoming Stars – Converters Stage – *we’ll get the cattle bedded down first and then nudging 7:15pm we’ll feature songs, “trick roping”, “gun wizardry”, and more!*

DAY 3 THURSDAY, JULY 23

- Cowboy Breakfast – on-site in the Wagon Wheel
- Morning Optional Breakfast Activities (*choose one and registration is requested for all listed activities*):
 - Attend Cheyenne Frontier Days Grand Parade – head for historic downtown Cheyenne; enjoy marching bands and antique carriages, automobiles and riders in period dress and Western gear! (*starts at 9:30am*)



- Mid-Morning Optional Frontier Days Activities (*choose one*):
 - Chuckwagon Cookoff – authentic chuckwagon crews compete in cooking demonstrations in Frontier Park beginning at 11am; this activity is held today and the next 2 days



- Western Apparel Hunt – stroll through selected Western Shops in historic Downtown Cheyenne
- Western Lunch – Gents and ladies clothing is modeled along with lunch
- President's Social & Dinner at Cheyenne's newest and most attractive "Little America" Conference Center [*part of the tonight's proceedings is "Cowboy PoetryTalk" by the Prevost/Converter Frontier Players!; club members judge photos of club members vying for prizes in "These Boots are Made for Walking" and "Flat Stanley and Flat Sandy Do Cheyenne" photo contests*]

DAY 4 FRIDAY, JULY 24

- Cowboy Breakfast – on-site in the Wagon Wheel

-Historic Cheyenne Street Railway Trolley Rides – fully-narrated historical city tours that capture the lively character of days gone by; tours are 90-minutes and there are 8 seats reserved for Prouds members at 10am, 11:30am, and 1pm rides (registration is required)

Old West Museum

-Walk through the CFD Old West Museum & Store – take a trip through the rich history of Cheyenne Frontier Days and a fantastic Frontier Days Western Art Show of traditional Western art; the club has put "25" tickets on "hold" for Prouds members today between 10am -3pm; just show your Prouds name badge (Registration is required)
